

Epoxy resin used to coat deteriorating manholes



Problem:

An April 2017 START Rehab project in Edmonton, Canada, required coating of 16 deteriorated manholes 94 1/2 inches in diameter that neck down to 47 1/4 inches.

Solution:

LaFarge-Holcim used **One-Step** 3-gallon kits of hand-applied epoxy resin **NPR-5305** from **Neopoxy**. The kit is easy to use since both parts of epoxy are preloaded in the same container. The product doesn't require any spray equipment, just an electrical drill with a paint blade and a spatula.

RESULT:

This application allowed for time savings during installation, easy-to-control coating thickness, low mobilization cost, less traffic disruption, a good quality coating, and cost reduction. **510/782-1290; www.neopoxy.us.**
